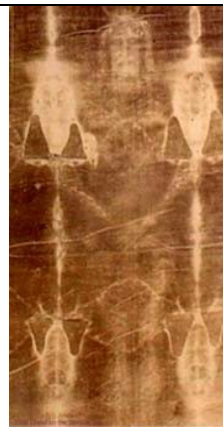

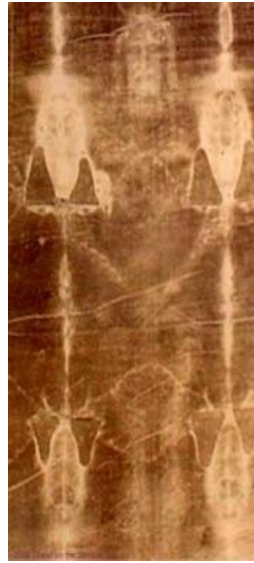

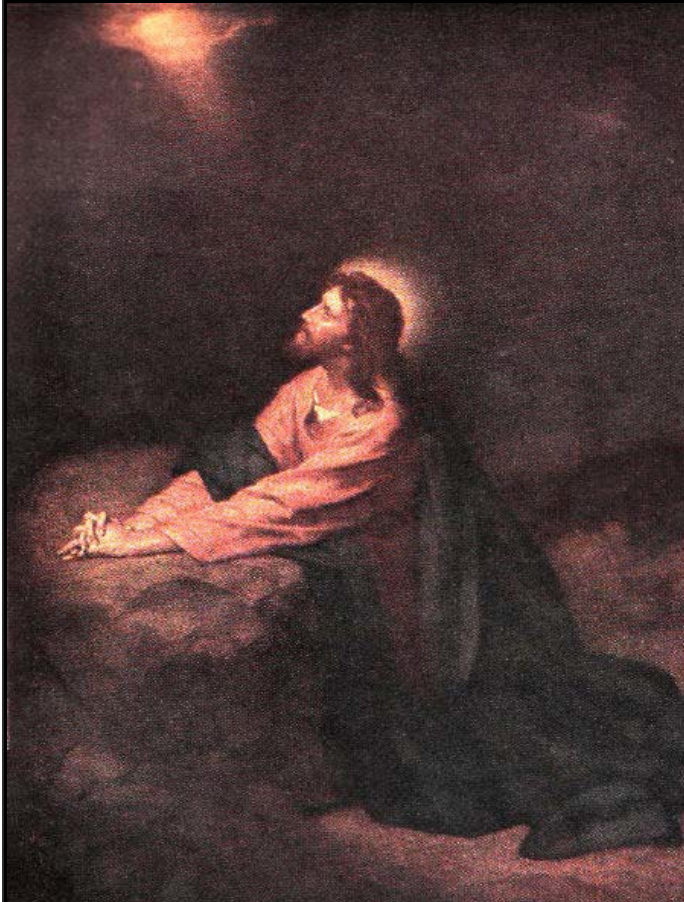

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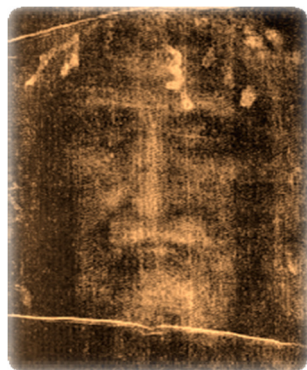

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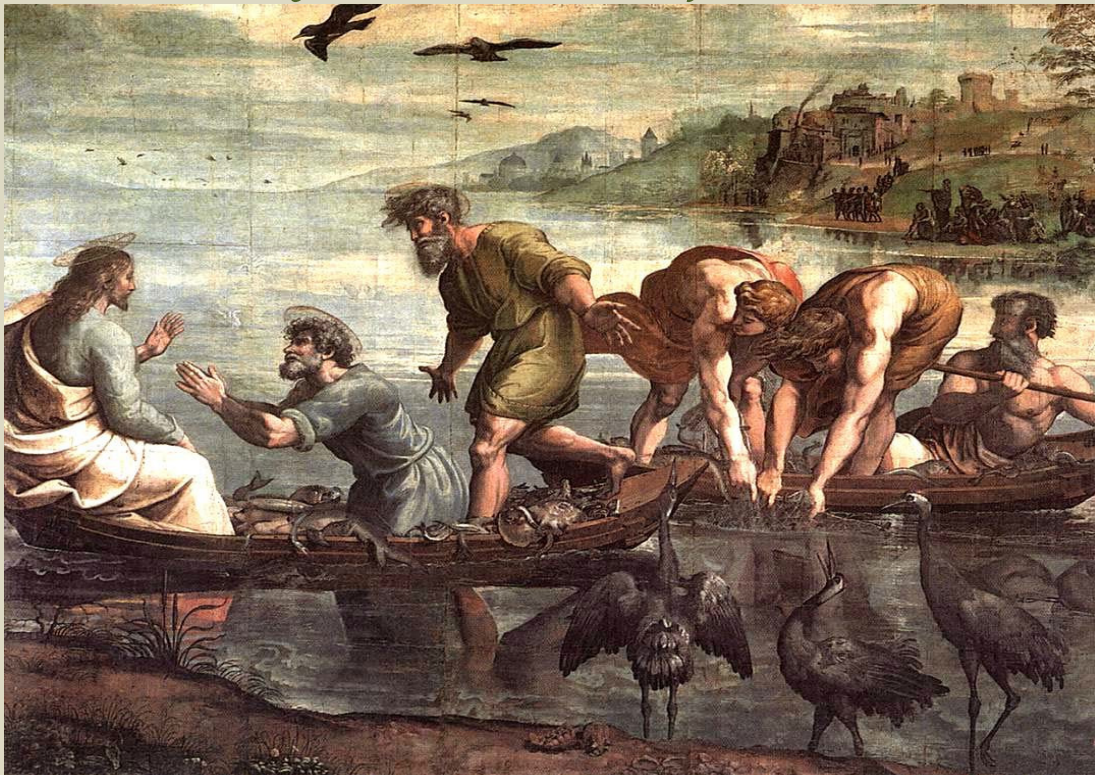

In 544, in the city of Edessa in Southeastern Turkey, a hidden burial cloth containing an image believed to be Jesus of Nazareth is found above a gate in the city's walls. The cloth is a burial shroud with full-body images and bloodstains described as a reflection produced by sweat, and divinely fashioned.

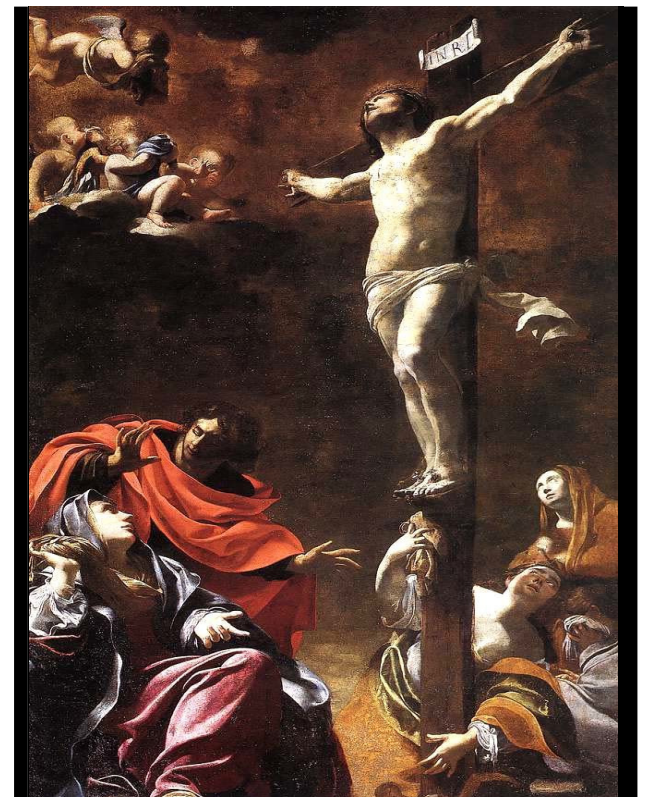

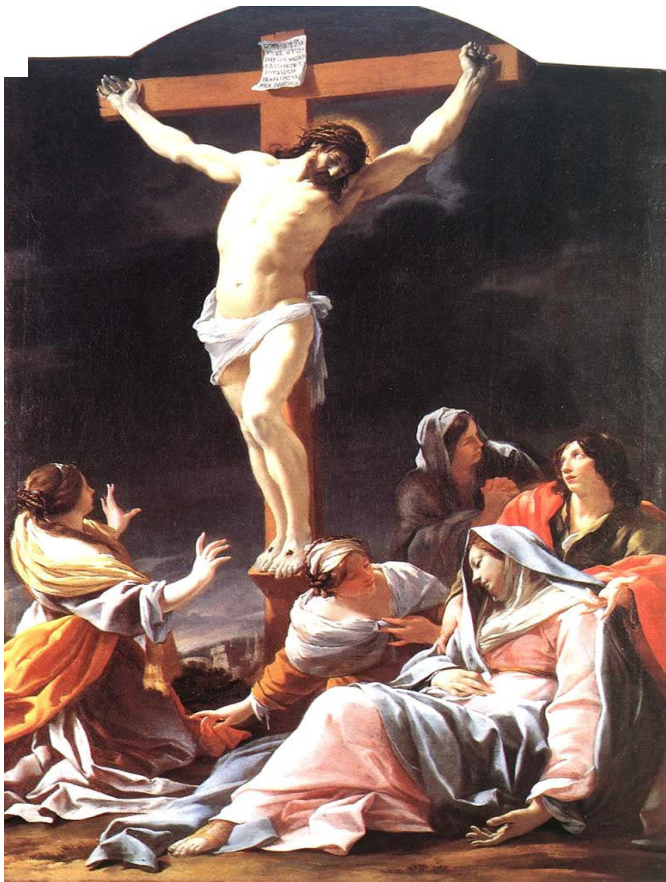

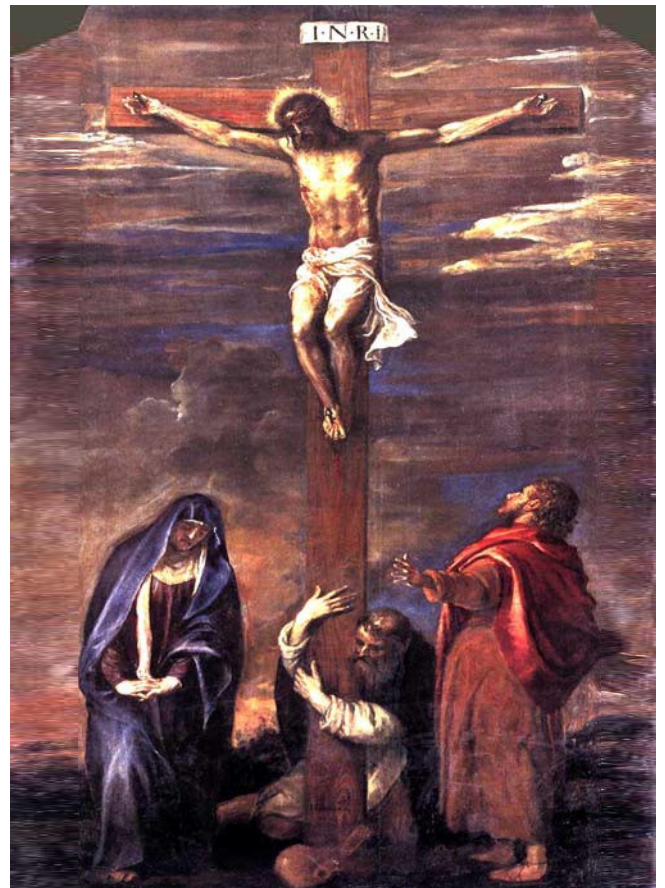

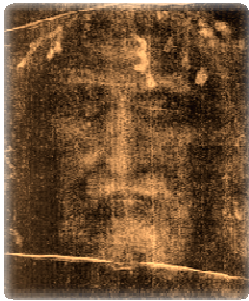
