

To date, no testing of any kind has proven that The Shroud of Turin is not the authentic burial cloth that wrapped Jesus Christ in His tomb. Yet, despite the overwhelming evidence of its authenticity, the Shroud of Turin remains the most controversial and emotional ambiguity in the history of the world.






